## The Quintessentially English hotel.....

The Berry Head Hotel is situated in what must be one of the most beautiful locations anywhere in the world. Combine that with a blend of personal service and friendly staff who are totally focused on the needs of their guests and you find a unique hotel, full of charm and atmosphere.

The House was built between 1801 and 1809 as a military hospital serving the Napoleonic forts at Berry Head. From 1833 until his death in 1847 it was occupied by Henry Francis Lyte and his family, and it was here that he wrote the famous hymn 'Abide with me' just four months before his death, inspired by his surroundings and the magnificent views.

The grounds were worked on by French prisoners of war who were given temporary shelter by Lyte after they were shipwrecked en-route to imprisonment. You will notice many trees, plants and herbs introduced during this time by Reverend Lyte from his visits abroad. Today the house retains much of its original charm nestling at the water's edge overlooking some of the finest sea and coastal views in the world.

It's six acres of private grounds and woodland adjoin the Berry Head Country Park, originally part of the Estate and now owned by the National Trust.

The Park which can be accessed from the grounds offers a Ramblers Paradise with miles of coastal path along the dramatic and unspoiled coastline to the River Dart and beyond, with small coves, rare wild flowers and a multitude of sea birds which find sanctuary in the cliffs. The Park is a designated area of Special Scientific Interest.





**'Food glorious food'** is a special part of any visit to the Berry Head and Fish is naturally a speciality, delivered daily from the market and also direct from local Brixham Trawlers.



We take pride in sourcing the very best quality food, wherever possible from local suppliers.

Our lamb is delivered from the South Hams, together with our cheeses and dairy products. Our beef is supplied by the family farm at Feniton Estate.

Our wines too have a local flavour with some fine wine from Sharpham Vineyard, and award winning Sparkling wines from Cornwall's Camel Valley Vineyard.

There is a choice of venue for dining, either from the 'View' Brasserie, or the more formal Bonaparte's restaurant which offers a four course table d'hote and A'la carte menu.

Whichever you choose you may be sure that the same care is taken in cooking, and in the selection of fine foods.

There is an indoor swimming pool and spa and petanque and croquet in the gardens.

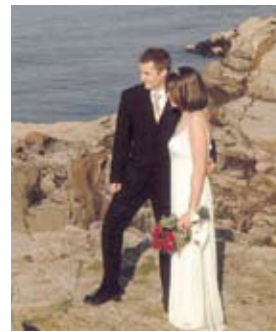


## As the Sun goes down.....

Free Wifi broadband connection is available in the library area.



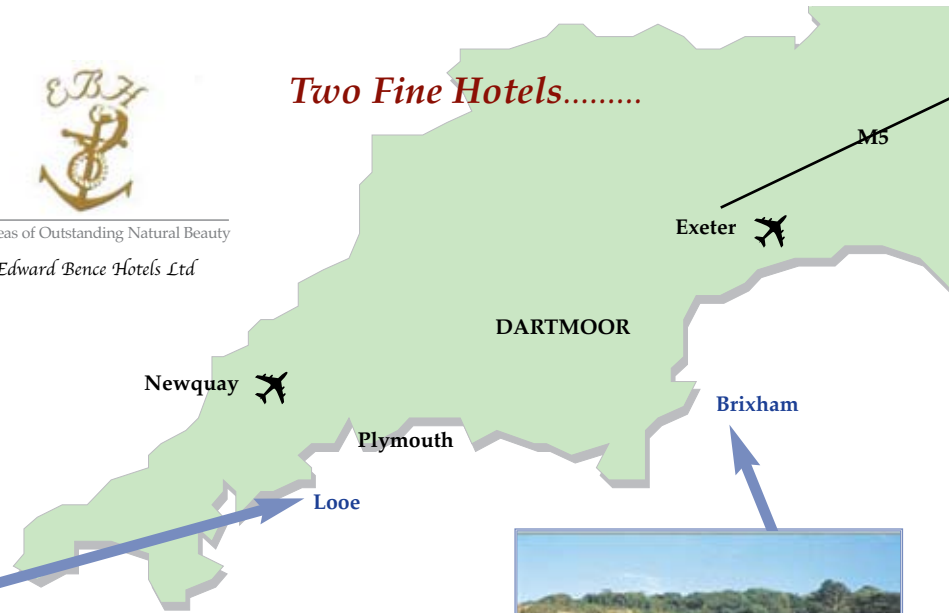
